Chart growth fashionably

Product - Forget marking up a two-by-four in the unfinished storage room every time your kid grows a couple inches. Why not chart those height milestones in a stylish way, for all to see?

That's the idea behind Growth Chart Art, an American company that uses designs by artist Ellen McCaleb on wooden growth charts to create functional art that can be hung in any room of the house.

Designs range from a sunflower chart to one with a ski or a lighthouse. The charts are eco-friendly, made with soy-based ink, no-VOC paint and repurposed wood. They range in price from \$49 to \$89 US and can be purchased online at growthchartart.com, which ships to Canada.
