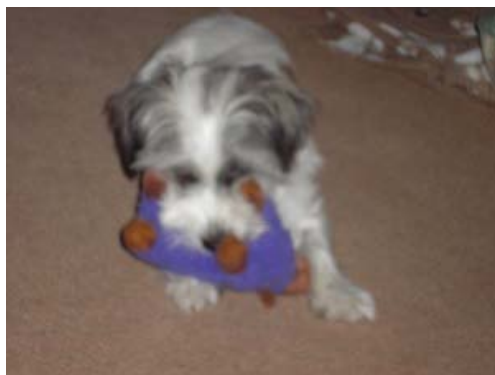


Espn tends to play with this one frequently.



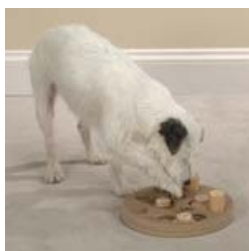

Like I said, Dazzle Dog Delight has it all, and then some!

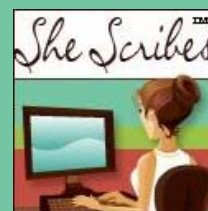
