« **BLENDING TETON VALLEY TRADITION** with technology and style, the **Teton Valley Creamery** in downtown Driggs opened with a bang last July with handmade gelato (Italian ice cream) and fresh, pasteurized cheese curds made with local milk. Moving into winter, cheese maker Kris Malling is focusing on artisan raw-milk cheeses (aged for a minimum of sixty days, by law), and the aging room is filling up with 8-10 lb. washed-rind Italian-style semi-firm rounds and 2 lb. mold-ripened cheeses with a blue vein. **Look for the cheeses to debut after the holidays at their retail store in the creamery, local restaurants, and Jackson Whole Grocer.**

WHILE NOT TECHNICALLY the “Tetons,” **Bear River Valley's** new affordable, minimally packaged, all-natural cereals from northern Utah are so yummy they deserve mention.
